

Curbside Recycling at El Parque

~ Revised Guidelines - April 2, 2026 ~

Leave the following recyclables by 8:30am at curbside

with 20-40 pesos clipped to a container

~ pickup is Wednesday or Thursday – please check weekly email from El Parque office ~

Must be separated into 4 containers, boxes or bags:

1. SOLID CONTAINERS:

- Clean **GLASS BOTTLES** and **JARS** only – **AND**
- Rinsed-out **METAL CANS** (aluminum, tin). Crush aluminum cans
 - **Include LIDS** (removed, but in same container)

2. FLEXIBLE CONTAINERS:

- Clean, crushed **PLASTIC BOTTLES** (milk bottles must be rinsed)
 - **Include CAPS** (removed, but in same container)
- **Tall berry containers, yogurt containers**
- **NO clam shell containers** • **NO pill bottles** • **NO thin or squishy plastic** (e.g. grocery store or bakery food containers or plastic egg cartons)

3. TETRA PAKS & THE LIKE:

- Flattened paperboard **CARTONS** (juice, milk, soup) – **Tetra Pak and others of similar shape** – rinse clean, include lid or cap

4. CARDBOARD (can be in a pile rather than container)

- **No paper!**
- Flatten cardboard (If you use a cardboard box to put recyclables into, we will leave it in front of your casa with the other containers so you can reuse it.)
 - **no boxes with food residue**

Containers and bags will be emptied and left in front of your casa.

BATTERIES / ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT: Bring to Lakeside Compushop & Repair, just before Pancho's Market in Riberas
